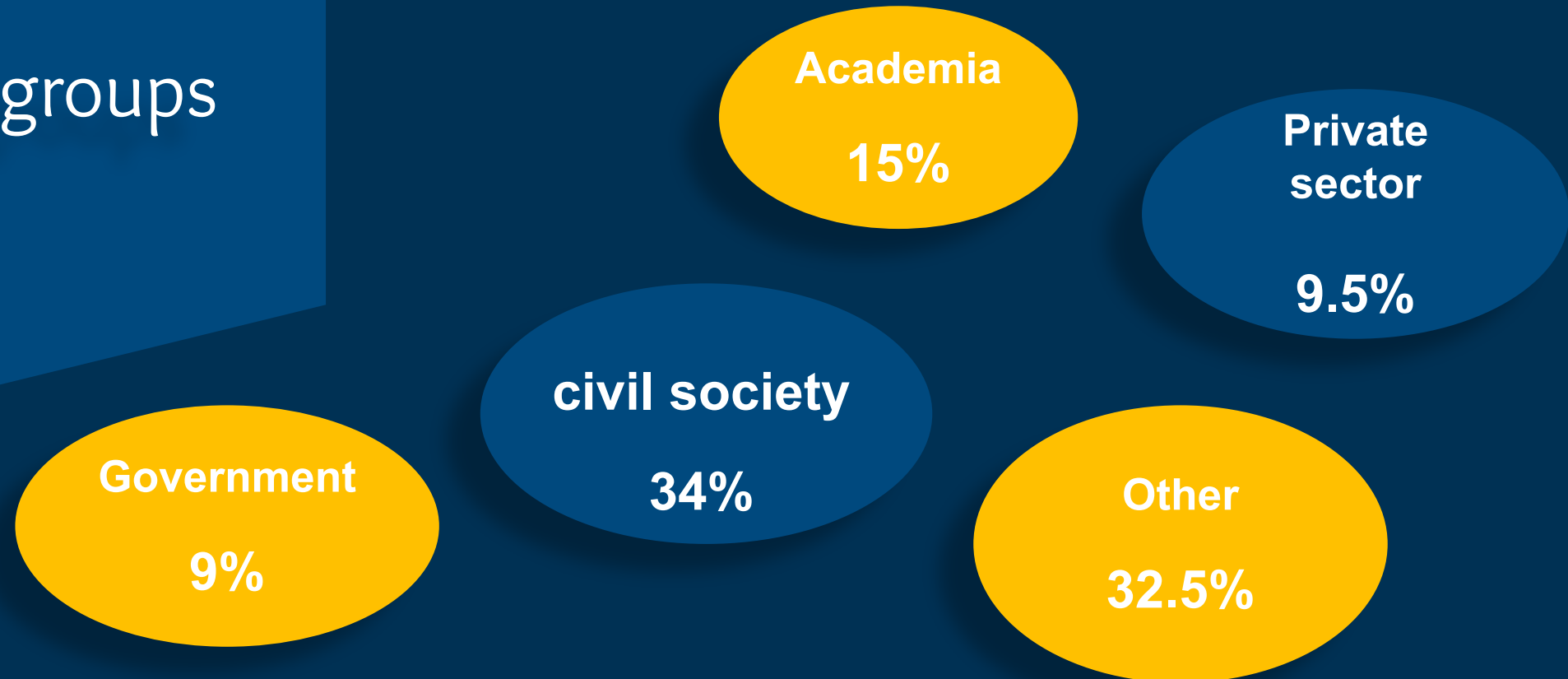

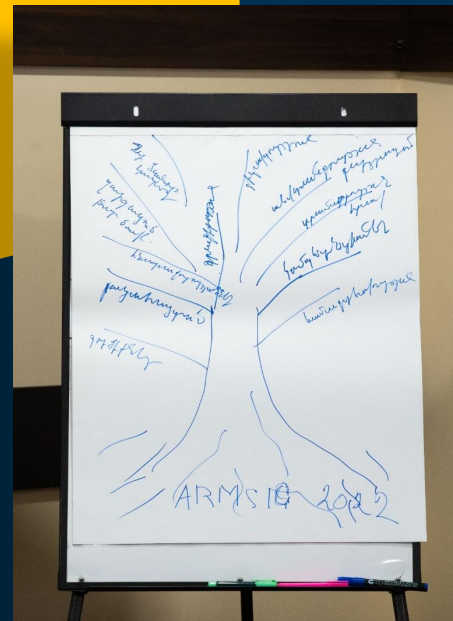
Summary
